IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

ANYONE NOT FOLLOWING THE IJF COVID-19 PROTOCOL WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT AND SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION!

The fundamental principle throughout all IJF/JUA events during the Covid-19 era is to protect and be protected by wearing a mask, sanitizing, distancing and respecting the recommendations of the IJF protocol. All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect one-another.

Each National Federation delegation participant (athlete, coach, team official, physiotherapist, doctor, President etc.) must have read and understood the latest version of the Protocol for resuming IJF events during the Covid-19 pandemic which can be found here:

covid.ijf.org

Before travelling

1. Check if you need a **visa**, and if yes request it from the organizer.
2. Book **accommodation** and send a detailed rooming list. Last minute changes can be accommodated whilst the delegation waits on the bus or outside the hotel.
3. Request **Exceptional Entry Permit** from the organizer. All participants should write to the organizer (: judolebanon@hotmail.com) to request the Exceptional Entry Permit. For each delegate send a good quality passport copy along with their arrival and departure dates.
4. Present on arrival, at least **two (2) Covid-19 negative** individual medical certificates. Please make sure the certificate also has an English version.

These **PCR tests MUST be made a maximum of five (5) days before arrival and taken 48 hours apart**. During this 5-day period you should stay isolated and limit contact with other people as much as possible. If you experience any kind of symptoms do not start to travel (even with two negative PCR tests).

5. Present upon arrival an individual **declaration of honour** and **liability release waiver** on the absence of symptoms for at least 14 days per delegate.

Entering Beirut

1. All regular border-crossing regulations must be followed regarding the validity of passports and visas, as applicable for each respective country.
2. All participants to the AOJC (even those who do not need a visa to enter Beirut) should be holding an **Exceptional Entry Permit** to be presented at passport control. This document is delivered by the Government of Lebanon. All participants should write to the organizer (: judolebanon@hotmail.com) to request this **important document**.

Entering the bubble

The event venues (hotels, sport hall, training hall etc.) will be classified as bubbles and to reduce risk a “bubble to bubble” concept will be used. **People are NOT allowed to leave their bubble** as contamination could occur endangering the safety of the event and the health of the participants.

PCR Tests:

1. At least **one (1) PCR test** per participant will be performed immediately upon arrival.

The test will be held at the airport:

Earliest arrival	29 November 2021
Latest arrival	72 hours before competition day
Test collection time	One day
Results issue within	Max. 24 hours

Until test results are obtained, all participants **must remain in their hotel rooms**, wherever and any paid meals will be ensured until the receipt of the test results.

2. A second local PCR test for athletes may be taken 24 hours before their competition with the results delivered before their weigh-in.

*This is the very latest arrival day. We recommend to arrive earlier.

Throughout your stay

1. Wash/sanitise your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object. Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the contest.
2. No handshake - greet each other with a bow.
3. Wear a mask at all times (change it at least twice a day). Exceptions: masks are not obligatory on the Field of Play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up or on the training tatami whilst training. Masks may be removed while eating in dining areas.
4. Maintain **1.5 m distance** at all times, except for competitors during training, their contests and during warming up with **ONE PARTNER**.
5. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the organizer on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the competition venue and at any official venue of the event, to be accepted by all accredited population.

Anyone registering a high temperature will be asked to remain outside and their Delegation COVID-19 Manager, the LOC COVID-19 Manager and the JUA COVID-19 Manager will be contacted. An opportunity to recheck their temperature will be given, if it is still high a final decision will be made by the LOC COVID-19 Manager and the JUA COVID-19 Manager.

Anyone with a positive test MUST stay in the quarantine hotel provided by the organizer. All expenses for his/her stay must be paid by the respective National Federation/country.

If a positive person takes another test during the quarantine period:

If positive	The quarantine period restarts for 10 days
If negative	Need to finish the original quarantine period (total 10 days)
When the quarantine period is over	Only if Negative he/her can leave Lebanon

Insurance:

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19-related costs. The organizer of the event and the JUA will not accept any liability or claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect a National Federation delegation member during the event.

LIABILITY RELEASE WAIVER

The World Health Organization has declared the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) a worldwide pandemic. Due to its capacity to transmit from person-to-person through respiratory droplets, the IJF has set recommendations, guidelines, and some prohibitions throughout the **Protocol for resuming IJF events during the COVID-19 pandemic (IJF COVID-19 Protocol)**. The IJF COVID-19 Protocol applies to all the IJF/JUA events' participants.

In consideration of my participation in the IJF/JUA events, I, the undersigned:

1. Confirm that I have taken good note of the IJF COVID Protocol and hereby undertake comply with it.
2. Acknowledge and agree to the following :
 - I am aware of the existence of the risk on my physical appearance to the venue and my participation to the IJF/JUA events that may cause injury or illness such as, COVID-19.
 - I have not experienced symptoms that of fever, fatigue, difficulty in breathing, or dry cough or exhibiting any other symptoms relating to COVID-19 or any communicable disease within the last 14 days.
 - I have not been, nor any of my household, diagnosed to be infected of COVID-19 virus within the last 30 days.
3. And, following the pronouncements above I hereby declare the following:
 - I am fully and personally responsible for my own safety and actions while and during participation and I recognize that I may be in any case be at risk of contracting COVID-19.

- Check out time: please check out before 12:00 pm. O' Clock (noon), if anybody would like to stay late, then he/she will be charged for one more day.

NOTE: Hotel reservations are made ONLY through the Organizer on a first come first serve basis. Hotel reservations must be made **before 26 October 2021, in Full payment on arrival in CASH**, subject to the following terms and conditions.

According to the new IJF rule enacted on the December 2, 2012 in Tokyo country should not request fee penalties for countries which cannot make bank transfers but can pay in cash money upon arrival. On the other hand, they should inform well in advance the organizing country and specify the number of participants before the deadline”.

Cancellation fees: up to 20 days before the hotel payment deadline, full refund. From 35 days before the arrival 50% of the payment. After the **Nov 20, 2021** any cancellation of rooms reserved or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs that must be paid by the participating National Federation. Cancellations of the rooms cannot be made at the check-in. Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.

IMPORTANT: All damages to property of hotels or venues resulting from the stay of a national delegation shall be charged to federation and paid in full.

- (b) In Cadets (boys and girls under 18) - each National Federation may enter 10 entries in total for boys and 10 entries for girls. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for boys and the same for girls will be allowed. The total delegation of both men and women is a maximum of 20 athletes. There is no open category.
- (c) In Juniors (men and women under 21) - each National Federation may enter 10 entries in total for men and 10 entries for women. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for men and the same for women will be allowed. The total delegation of both men and women is a maximum of 20 athletes. There is no open category.

14. INSCRIPTION FEES

Contestant must hold the same nationality of their Federation. Contestants are required to show his / her passport in order to confirm their nationality.

19. JUDOGI & BACKNUMBER: In accordance with the IJF and JUA regulations.

20. INSURANCE:

Each National (Regional) Federation / Association will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Judo Union of Asia, the Organizing Committee of Asian Oceania Cadet & Junior Judo Championships 2021, and the Lebanese Judo Federation will not be responsible of any claims of illness, injury and death, of any participants/officials whatsoever.

Contestants are required to attend the awarding ceremony in White Judogi with bare foot.

The Accreditation will be held on 30th November and 1st December 2021, at Hotel Burj
