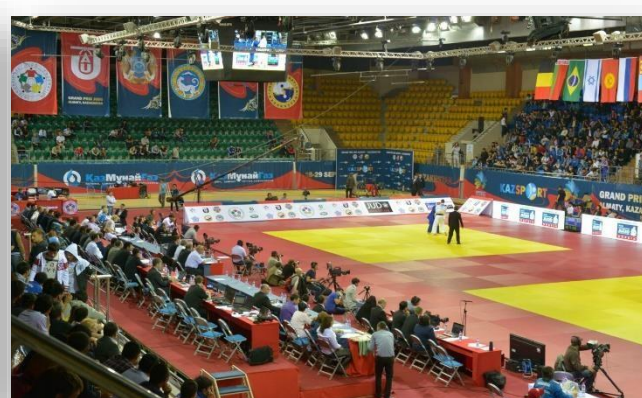

Payment

Payment method – Bank transfer or cash (USD)

According to the IJF rule enacted on 2 December 2012 in Tokyo, "the organizing country should not request penalties fee for participating countries who cannot make bank transfers but can pay in cash upon arrival. Those countries who cannot make bank transfers should inform the LOC well in advance that they will pay cash on arrival". All bank fees and bank transfer costs must be paid by the participating

If payment is being made by bank transfer the bank information must be inserted correctly and completely on the transfer document and any procedures related to the amendment of the bank transfer must be done before arrival. Delegations must ensure that all bank charges are paid at their end so that the LOC receives the correct amount of funds without any deductions. The delegation must have proof of the bank transfer, upon arrival.

5. PARTICIPATION RULES

BEFORE TRAVELLING

Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of arrival.

Check if you need a visa, and if yes, request it from the LOC according to the details in the visa section.

- Book accommodation with the LOC and send a detailed rooming list. Last-minute changes can be accommodated whilst the delegation waits on the bus or outside the hotel.
- Check host country entry requirements and airline requirements (if applicable). Upload before arrival to my.ijf.org an individual Liability Release Waiver (LRW). The document can be found in the documents section under the link:

MINOR ATHLETES

The National Federation is responsible for obtaining legal approval and permission for minor athletes to compete in competitions. When travelling with minors the team official/coach must have all the necessary documents in place that authorizes them to act on behalf of the parents/guardians “in loco parentis”.

The Organizer will provide land transportation from Almaty International Airport to the official hotels and back. During the competitions, transportation will be provided between the venue and the hotel ONLY to accredited delegations.

11. PARTICIPATION

All the participants must have valid IJF ID card, otherwise, registration for this event is not possible. This JUA Cup Cadets is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participants for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them. In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the National Federation of the country of which the athlete holds the passport should be presented during the accreditation.

12. COMPETITION RULES

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Men & Women – Four (4) minutes (Real Time)

The “Golden score” with no time limit. The referee’s decision is canceled.

13. REFEREES

Each participating countries may enter TWO (2) referees at maximum. Referees must have IJF International or Continental Referee License.

14. WEIGH-IN

Official weigh-in for each weight category is held the evening before the competition day (see program). Athletes must present accreditation card, IJF ID card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

15. DRAW

The draw will be conducted online at 17:00 on 6 April.

16. JUDO GI

Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.

Judogi Control

It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDO GI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label can be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

National Emblem

Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100 cm².

17. COACHING

Code of behavior of coaches as defined in the Sports and Organization Rules, Annex 4 will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.

Coaches are not allowed to give indications to the competitors while they are fighting.

Only during the pause time (after matte), coaches will be permitted to give indications to their athletes. - After the pause is finished, and the fight continues (hajime), coaches will have to keep silent again.

If a coach doesn't follow these rules, they can be expelled from the competition area.

If the coach persists with this behavior from outside the competition area, they could be penalized.

1st Place – Gold Medal with Diploma

2nd Place – Silver Medal with Diploma

3rd Place – Bronze Medal with Diploma
