7. INSURANCE

Each National Federation is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the gender control are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, during the Competition.

The organizer and JUA will not be responsible for any insurance related to the above mentioned matters. Nevertheless the National Judo Federation staging the competitions shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

9. PARTICIPATION

This JUA Cup Cadets is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participation for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them. In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the National Federation of the country of which the athlete holds the passport should be presented during the accreditation.

10. COMPETITION RULES

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Men & Women – Four (4) minutes (Real Time)

The “Golden score” with no time limit. Referees’ decision is cancelled.

11. REFEREES

Each participating countries may enter TWO (2) referees at maximum.
Referees must have IJF International or Continental Referee License.

12. WEIGH-IN

Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits.

Athletes must present accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

13. DRAW

a. The draw will be conducted at **17:00 on 10 August. Place will be TBD.**

b. Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw, a maximum of three (3) delegates per National Federation (2 officials and 1 athletes’ delegate) will be authorized.

14. JUDO GI

Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi (supplied by one of the following manufacturers: Greenhill, SFJAM NORIS, DANRHO, MIZUNO, Double D Adidas, HAYAKAWA, Fighting Film, Budo Sport AG, ESSIMO, MATSURU B.V.).

Judogi Control

It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDO GI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label can be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

Backnumber

Each competitor taking part in the JUA/IJF events is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi the official IJF backnumber bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumber can be ordered from www.ijfbacknumber.com or www.mybacknumber.com (Attention: production and delivery takes around 4 weeks). The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.

National Emblem

Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm².

15. COACHING

Code of behavior of coaches as defined in the Sports and Organization Rules, Annex 4 will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.

- Coaches are not allowed to give indications to the competitors while they are fighting.
- Only during the pause time (after matte), coaches will be permitted to give indications to their athletes.
- After the pause is finished, and the fight continues (hajime), coaches will have to keep silent again.
- If a coach doesn't follow these rules, they can be expelled from the competition area.
- If the coach persists with this behavior from outside the competition area, they could be penalized.

16. ANTI DOPING CONTROL

The gold medal winner and one of the key medalists in each category will participate in doping control.

17. AWARDS AND PRIZES

- 1st Place – Gold Medal with Diploma
- 2nd Place – Silver Medal with Diploma
- 3rd Place – Bronze Medal with Diploma
- 5th Place – Diploma

18. VISA

For nations who need VISA to enter Kazakhstan, please send the enclosed "Visa Application Form" fully filled not later than Monday, August 11, 2014.
