## **1. Report of the President**

**Dear Executive Committee Members & Members and Representatives of JUA Member Countries,**

It is my pleasure to welcome you all in the JUA EC Meeting today 5<sup>th</sup> February 2015 in Kuwait, and invite you all for the JUA Ordinary Congress, scheduled to be held on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2015 at Kuwait.

I would like to express my heartily thanks to everyone for choosing me as President and your kind support and cooperation to do my duties since April 2011. I am glad to submit a brief report since last JUA Congress, Thailand, for your information please.

1. Judo Union of Asia has consistently followed the International Judo Federation Rules, with respect to IJF Refereeing rules, IJF Sports Organization Rules and IJF Coaching Regulations along with Uniformity in Regulations and Statutes.
2. There have been numerous Judo Events successfully organized and conducted in Asia during the year 2014. That includes;  
  
Nanjing Youth Olympics 2014.  
Incheon Asian Games 2014  
Hongkong Asian Junior and Cadet Championships.  
Bangkok Asian Kata Championships  
Tokyo and Abu Dhabi Grand Slams  
Ulanbaatar, Tashkent, Astana, Qingdao and Jeju Grand Prix  
Asian Open Judo Championships in Chinese Taipei.
3. Continuing with the Successful Judo events in Asia for the year 2014.. includes  
Referee Seminars and Referee Exams  
Sports Organization Seminar and Examination.  
Education Seminar and Kata Seminar  
Kata Judges Examination.  
Judo Cadet Tournaments  
Judo Junior Judo events, Seniors Judo Events and Regional Judo Events.
4. For this year 2015 we have  
JUA Congress in Kuwait on 11 May 2015.  
JUA Senior Judo Championships in Kuwait on 13 and 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2015.  
JUA Senior Team Championships in Kuwait on 15 May 2015.  
And JUA Junior and Cadet Championships which is to be decided..
5. Coming to the Asian Judo Performance during the year 2014,



Foremost of all, we had Chelyabinsk Russia World Judo Championships from 25 Aug until 31 Aug, 2014 having Asian Tally of 16 medals that included 3 medals for the Teams.  
(Japan won gold in Team Men's, Mongolia Silver in Womens, Japan the Bronze for Women.)

6. We had Nanjing China Youth Olympics from 17<sup>th</sup> Aug until 21 August, 2014 for Judo sports, where Asian Judokas secured 8 medals in 8 of the categories specified for Judo. Japan got 2, and 1 each by Kazakhstan, Iran, Kyrgyzstan, Korea, Uzbekistan and China.
7. Asian Judokas performance has been for the Grand Slams as;  
  
34 medals at Tokyo Grand Slam  
7 medals at Abu Dhabi Grand Slam  
17 medals at the Tyumen Russia Grand Slam  
8 medals at the Baku Azerbaijan Grand Slam  
17 medals at the Paris, France Grand Slam.
8. Our Judokas secured good results in Grand Prix events conducted all over Asia, as  
21 medals in Jeju Korea Grand prix  
22 medals in Qingdao, China Grand prix  
17 medals in Tashkent, Uzbekistan Grand prix  
16 medals in Astana, Kazakhstan Grand prix  
30 medals at the Ulanbaatar, Mongolia Grand prix.
9. As a result you can witness a very successful year for the year 2014.  
Given increased Judo Exposure with lot more competitive settings in Judo events.  
Has witnessed many techniques in Judo and pleasant display of Judo sporting.  
There has been increased interest for holding Judo events at many places around the world.
10. Now, I have the recommendation about the Team Championships for the Judo Junior Category. We have seen that International Judo Federation since recently started organizing Junior Judo Team Championships, and therefore, I would like to evaluate the possibility of the Junior Team Championships in Asia as well.
11. I thank very much Mr. Marius Vizer for having taken up the strong initiative and thorough approach for bringing up Judo in Asia and worldwide.

I foresee better future and we look for grass-root level training in Judo for the Cadets and sub Cadet levels. There will be more worldwide exposure for Judo and get good general public viewing. I also foresee we are going to use much Technological advancement in Event management.

Judo Events in London Olympics were organized from 28<sup>th</sup> July to 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2012 at Excel, London. 154 Female and 233 Male Judokas from 135 Countries participated in the Judo Events of Olympics 2012. Judo players from 21 countries won medals and Six of these Countries are from Asia, as per the details given below:

### **Asian Games – 2014, Incheon**

Judo Events in Incheon Asian Games 20 ~ 22, September 2014 at Incheon, Korea . 124 Men and 81 Women Judokas participated from 33 Countries.

As per the medal tally, Japan placed overall Championship by winning 5 Gold, 4 Silver and 4 Bronze medals, South Korea placed Runner-up by winning 4 Gold, 1 Silver and 8 Bronze medals, and Mongolia placed third by winning 3 Gold, 3 Silver and 4 Bronze medals.
