



Taipei International Junior Judo Open 2013

New Taipei City, August 3-4, 2013

REGULATIONS

- 1. Date** : August 3(Saturday) and August 4(Sunday), 2013
- 2. Venue** : Hsin-Chuang Gymnasium, New Taipei City
(No. 82, Jhongheng Rd., Sinjhuang City, New Taipei City 242)
- 3. Supervisor** : Sports Administration, Ministry of Education 、 Chinese Taipei Olympic Committee 、 New Taipei City Government
- 4. Organizer** : Chinese Taipei Judo Federation
- 5. Program** : August 1 (Thu.): Arrival for National teams and officials
August 2 (Fri.): Referees' Meeting /Managers' Meeting /Draw/Welcome party
August 3-4 (Sat.-Sun.): Competitions
August 5 (Mon.): Departure of all National Delegates
- 6. Invitee Country** : All IJF/JUA Member Federations/Associations
- 7. Contestants Age** : Boys and Girls must be above 16 years and under 21 years (must be born between 1993 and 1997)
- 8. Nationality** : Contestants must hold the same nationality of their National Federation. Contestants are required to show their passports in order to confirm their nationality.
- 9. Divisions** : Individual contests by weight categories
BOYS: -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, +81kg (Max.100kg)
GIRLS: -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, +63kg (Max.78kg)
- 10. Contest Time** : Boy & Girl – Four (4) minutes (Real Time)
- 11. Entries** : Each Federation/Association may enter TWO (2) contestants in each category at maximum.
The host country may enter THREE (3) contestants in each category at maximum
- 12. Deadlines** : Preliminary Entry by number: June 15, 2013
Final Entry: July 1, 2013
Travel Schedule and Hotel Reservation: July 1, 2013
- 13. Composition of Team** : Officials: 1. One(1) Team Leader
2. Two(2) Team Referees-with IJF A/B License
3. Two(2) Team Coaches
Competitors: 4. Eight(8) or fewer Boy contestants
5. Eight(8) or fewer Girl contestants

*TOTAL for a team of 21 people at maximum including 16 contestants (Boys & Girls), 5 officials.

- 15. Conditions** : The number of officials is composed as follow:
- One official for a total of 1-4 contestants
 - Two officials for a total of 5-8 contestants
 - Four officials for a total of 9-13 contestants
 - Five officials for a total of 14-16 contestants
- The Organizer will cover the expenses for accommodations, meals, and land transportation for at maximum 21 persons including 16 contestants (boys & girls) and 5 officials in the duration of invitation period.
- Invitation Period: From August 1st (Thursday)-August 5th (Monday)**
(4 nights/5days free including 3 lunches and 4 dinners)
- **The allocation of rooms is done by the organizing committee. If there is an additional number of participants other than those listed, an extra person shall bear his/her own accommodation expenses. (USD\$120 per person per night in Twin-room and USD\$150 per person per night in Single-room /with full board).
- 16. Transportation** : The Organizing Committee will provide land transportation from Taoyuan International Airport to official hotels upon arrival and to airport on departure. During the competitions, transportation will be provided between the venue and hotel at predetermined times and schedules.
- 17. Judogi** : White and Blue Judogi will be used.
- 18. Ceremonies** : Contestants are required to attend the opening and awarding ceremonies in official track-suit or White Judogi. It is expected that each delegation will have a uniform appearance.
- 19. Insurance** : Each National Federation / Association will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Organizing Committee of Taipei International Junior Judo Open and Chinese Taipei Judo Federation will not be responsible of any claims of illness, injury and death.
- 20. National Flag** : Each National Federation/Association is required to bring two(2)National Flags(120cmX180cm) and National Anthem(short version in CD) for the opening ceremony.
- 21. Prizes** :
- 1st place --Gold Medal with diploma
 - 2nd place --Silver Medal with diploma
 - 3rd place x 2 --Bronze Medals with diplomas
 - 5th place x 2 --Diplomas
- 22. Methods of Competition** : Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.
