12. Entries	This competition is open for all JUA / IJF Member Federations: □Maximum FOUR (4) competitors per weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.
13. Accreditation & Control of entries	At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Thu. 05.09.2013 from 12:00 to 21:00 and Fri. 06.09.2013 from 09:00 to 15:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or national ID card with photography or photocopy of a document).
14. Age	Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1998 or before)
15. Competition Mode	The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest rules and sporting codes of the IJF SOR and JUA. Competition System: Elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.
16. Duration of contests	Men & Women : Five (5) minutes (real time). “Golden Score” with no time limit.
17. Weight Categories	Men: -60kg; -66 kg; -73 kg; -81 kg; -90 kg; -100 kg; +100kg. Women: -48kg; -52kg; -57kg; -63kg; -70kg; -78kg; +78kg.
18. Prizes	1 st place-Gold Medal with diploma 2 nd place-Silver Medal with diploma 3 rd place x 2-Bronze Medals with diplomas 5 th place x 2-Diplomas
19. Weigh-in	Athletes must present their accreditation card at the official weigh-in. For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program. The scales for check of the weight will be provided in Sunworld Dynasty Hotel from 5 th September.
20. Refereeing	Each participating countries may enter ONE (1) referee with at least continental or international license. The organizing federation may enter a maximum of FOUR (4) referees . The referee meeting will take place on September 6 th at 16:00.

21. Draw	Seeding of the top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations. The draw will take place on September 6th at 17:00 in Sunworld Dynasty Hotel, Congress Hall . Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials. Dress code: jacket suit with tie
22. Entry Fees	An entry fee of USD100 per athlete must be paid to the JUA during accreditation.
23. Coaching	All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Dress Code: □ Draw: jacket suit and tie □ Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit and tie □ For the final block program: jacket suit with tie.
24. National Flag	Each National Federation/Association is required to bring two (2) National Flags (120cmX180cm) and National Anthem (short version in CD) for the opening ceremony.
25. Judogi	The white and blue judogi are obligatory. Judogi control according to the Sokuteiki Rule. All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. See Official Suppliers on the IJF website. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the IJF regulations. If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.
26. Back Numbers	Each competitor taking part in the JUA events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 IJF back number . The back number must be the official IJF one. It should be ordered from www.ijfbacknumber.com Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it by themselves using the special glue on the back number.
