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General Information

19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 Sport Entries Manual

1.1 Introduction

The Olympic Council of Asia (hereinafter referred to as the OCA) and the 19th Hangzhou Asian Games Organising Committee (hereinafter referred to as HAGOC) have joined together to formulate the sport entries procedures for the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 (hereinafter referred to as Hangzhou 2022).

The purpose of this Manual is to introduce sport entries procedures, relevant policies and requirements for filling out the Sport Entry Forms for Hangzhou 2022 to NOCs in Asia.

As stated in Article 53 of the current *OCA Constitution and Rules*, only NOCs recognised by the OCA can send athletes to enter competition in the Asian Games.

The 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 will be held in Hangzhou, China from 10 September to 25 September 2022. With the approval of the OCA, the sport entries for Hangzhou 2022 will be conducted in three stages. The NOC need to submit the Sport Entry Forms at each stage:

Entry by Sport: Each NOC submits official entry forms confirming in which sports it intends to compete in Hangzhou 2022. (Deadline: 15 February 2020)

Entry by Number: Each NOC submits official entry forms confirming the number of athletes it is entering in each event in all Sports and Disciplines in Hangzhou 2022. (Deadline: 14 January 2022)

Entry by Name: Each NOC is required to submit official entry forms for all participating athletes. This is the final sport entries phase for Hangzhou 2022. (Deadline: 30 June 2022)

1.3 Instructions to Sport Entries

1.3.1 Sport Entry Form

For sport entries, NOCs are required to complete and submit the following entry forms:

Entry by Number Form

Entry by Number refers to the procedure where each NOC provides the number of its athletes participating in each event based on HAGOC's sports events programme and entry policies. In the Entry by Number Form, instead of providing athletes' names, NOCs only need to enter the number of male and female athletes participating in each event and the total number of athletes at this stage (athletes participating in multiple events will be counted only once). The Entry by Number Form shall be signed and sealed for confirmation.

NOCs participating in Hangzhou 2022 are required to send the Entry by Number Forms by e-mail to the Sport Entries Centre of the Sports Department of HAGOC by 24:00 on 14 January 2022 (Beijing time).

Please refer to page 17 of this Manual for an Entry by Number Form sample.

Entry by Name Form

Each NOC-designated athlete and sports team qualified to participate in Hangzhou 2022 must fill out the Entry by Name Form (for individual or team). Athletes should sign their names in the signature column of the Individual Entry Form. Each Form should be signed and stamped by athletes' respective NOC and the concerned National Sports Federation (NF) to serve as the final legal documents for their participation in Hangzhou 2022.

Please refer to page 18 of this Manual for an Entry by Name Form sample.

Returned Summary Form (Entry by Name)

Each NOC participating in Hangzhou 2022 are required to submit a signed, stamped and confirmed Returned Summary Form when submitting Entry by Name Forms to HAGOC as the confirmation of the receipt of all Sport Entry Forms. Please mail Entry by Name Forms and the Returned Summary Form to HAGOC Sport Entries Centre, or e-mail the above-mentioned documents (in PDF format) to sportentry@hangzhou2022.cn by 24:00, 30 June 2022 (Beijing Time).

Please refer to page 19 of this Manual for a Returned Forms Summary Form sample.

1.3.2 Entry Method (Entry by Name)

In order to promote the process of Entry by Name of Hangzhou 2022, HAGOC will provide NOCs with Entry by Name Forms (in PDF format) for all events on 31 March 2022, so that NOCs and their NFs can collect information on athletes.

The Sport Entries System (Entry by Name) is expected to be available from 3 May to 30 June 2022. The *Online Sport Entries System User Manual* will be e-mailed to each NOC before the Sport Entries System goes online. At that time, NOCs can enter the official website of Hangzhou 2022 (https://www.hangzhou2022.cn), enter the athletes' information online, and print out the Sport Entry Forms after the completion of all the entries. All Entry by Name forms printed out from the online Sport Entries System must be signed and stamped by NOCs. Before the Sport Entries System (Entry by Name) is closed (before 30 June 2022, Beijing time), each NOC should e-mail the abovementioned forms (in PDF format) to sportentry@hangzhou2022.cn, or mail it to HAGOC Sport Entries Centre.

To facilitate the process of Delegation Registration Meetings (DRMs), as well as the verification and review of information, we strongly recommend that the original/hard copies of the Athlete-signed and NOC-stamped Entry by Name Forms by NOCs can reach HAGOC Sport Entries Centre no later than 48 hours prior to the commencement of DRMs.

Note:

To ensure the accuracy of the entry information, the information of Entry by Name will be subject to the data in the Sport Entries System.

1.3.3 Instructions on Completing Sport Entry Forms

Whichever method is adopted, NOCs are required to adhere to the following guidelines when completing Sport Entry Forms:

- Only athletes who comply with the *OCA Constitution and Rules* and its Bye-law, as well as the regulations of the International Sports Federations (IFs)/Asian Sports Federations (AFs) of each sport are allowed to participate.
- Before filling in the Entry by Name Form, please read carefully the instructions for filling in the form for each relevant sport.
- Please follow the sport-specific notes/instructions given on the Entry by Name Form.
- The entry policies of each sport in this Manual are for reference only. Please carefully read the competition format, entry policy and other concerned content in the Sport Technical Handbook of each sport.
- Before completing the Sport Entry Forms of Rhythmic Gymnastics, Modern Pentathlon, Squash, and Sepaktakraw, please read carefully the instructions for filling, as well as the sections of Competition Events, Competition Format, Sport Entries, etc. in their Sport Technical Handbooks.
- Please refer to Appendix 1 of this Manual for the Sports Events Programme of Hangzhou 2022.

- Please refer to Appendix II of this Manual for the NOC Codes.
- Please refer to Appendix V of this Manual for horse breeds and horse colours.
- Each Sport Entry Form must be completed clearly and in its entirety without any corrections.
- Please enter any dates requested on a Sport Entry Form in the following format: dd/ mm/yyyy.

For example: 12 November 2021= 12/11/2021

All Sport Entry Forms should be completed in English using CAPITAL LETTERS in Latin characters and numbers. Letters and numbers should follow the printed style below:

ABCDEFGHIJKLMNOPQRSTUVWXYZ

- All fields in a Sport Entry Form must be completed unless indicated otherwise.
- The signature and stamp of each NOC President or Secretary General and the President or Secretary General of the concerned NF must appear at the bottom of the Sport Entry Forms submitted. Please ensure that the signature and NOC and NF's stamp should not obscure any information entered onto the form.
- All athletes participating in a team event will also need to complete the Sport Entry Form (for individual) for the event.
- The Returned Summary Forms also needs to be signed and stamped by NOCs for confirmation.

Note: The information required on the Sport Entry Forms such as the Name of NOC, NOC Code, Accreditation Number, Date of Birth, Preferred Family Name and Preferred Given Name must be consistent with the information given for each athlete on the Accreditation Application Form.

1.3.4 Eligibility Code and Athletes Signature

To be eligible to take part in Hangzhou 2022, all athletes must read and endorse the Eligibility Code (please refer to Appendix III), and sign the Athlete declaration on the relevant Sport Entry Form.

Note: No original Individual Entry Form will be accepted without the signature of the athlete.

1.4 Entry Deadlines

Entry by Number: 29 November 2021 to 24:00, 14 January 2022 (Beijing Time, GMT +8)

Entry by Name: 31 March 2022 to 24:00, 30 June 2022 (Beijing Time, GMT +8)

Note: All NOCs should ensure that the accreditation applications for all athletes (reserve athletes included) have been submitted by 10 May 2022

1.6 Late Athlete Replacement Policy

The deadline for the submission of Entry by Name Forms for all athletes for Hangzhou 2022 is 30 June 2022. DRMs will be held from 27 August to 9 September 2022. When the information on the Entry by Name Form is consistent with the original form submitted at the DRM, the final list of entries will be formed.

However, under exceptional circumstances (e.g. due to injury or other medical emergency) and on a case-by-case basis, the OCA and the relevant IFs/AFs, after consulting with the appropriate medical specialists, may allow the permanent replacement of an athlete by another after 30 June 2022 provided that:

- 1. The replacement athlete is entitled and eligible in accordance with the *OCA Constitution and Rules*;
- 2. The NOC to which the replacement athlete belongs, had applied for accreditation for the replacement athlete prior to the accreditation application deadline of 10 May 2022; and
- 3. The replacement athlete has never received any sanction for violating anti-doping rules/policies.

In addition, replacement can be requested one day prior to the Technical Meeting held by HAGOC, while the following procedures must be complied with:

- 1.The relevant NOC must duly complete an Official Athlete Replacement Form;
- 2. Each NOC must submit a medical certificate of the athlete to be replaced;
- 3.The Hangzhou Asian Games Identity and Accreditation Card (HAGIAC) of the replacement athlete must be recalled and submitted to the Accreditation Centre (ACC) or the Venue Accreditation Office (VAO).

- 4. The relevant NOC shall complete the Entry by Name Forms for the replacement athletes.
- 5. Athletes to be replaced must abide by relevant COVID-19 prevention and control policies of HAGOC.

All replacement requests and relevant documents should be submitted to HAGOC Sport Entries Centre in order to perform relevant procedures. The HAGOC Sport Entries Centre will forward copies of all relevant documents submitted to the Accreditation Centre and the OCA Sports Committee.

These replacement policies may be adjusted or revised by the OCA for exceptional circumstances.

Competitor's declaration

All athletes must read and abide by the Eligibility Code (see Appendix III), and sign their names in the Individual Entry Form to be eligible to participate in Hangzhou 2022.

Preferred family name

The preferred family name used in the Sport Entry Form must be consistent with the preferred family name on the Accreditation Application Form.

Preferred given name

Each NOC is limited to two athletes in each event.

Relay events

Each NOC is limited to one team (4 athletes) per event.

Each NOC is limited to 40 male athletes and 40 female athletes (including substitutes) to participate.

The preferred family name used in the Sport Entry Form must be consistent with the preferred family name on the Accreditation Application Form.

Preferred given name

The preferred given name used in the Sport Entry Form must be consistent with the preferred given name on the Accreditation Application Form.

Gender

Please indicate the athlete's gender (male/female) with " $\sqrt{\ }$ " in the corresponding blank.

Internationally recognised name

Leave it blank if there isn't one.

Date of birth

Please enter the date(s) of birth in the following format: dd/mm/yyyy. Please enter the date(s) of birth using the following format: dd/mm/yyyy.

Competitor's declaration

All athletes must read and abide by the Eligibility Code (see Appendix III), and sign their names in the Individual Entry Form to be eligible to participate in Hangzhou 2022.

Entry Policy

Individual event

Each NOC may enter a maximum of two (2) athletes per event.

Synchronised event

Each NOC may enter a maximum of one (1) pair of athletes per event.

Total

Each NOC may enter a maximum of eight (8) male athletes and eight (8) female athletes.

Regulations

Divers younger than 14 years by 31 December 2022 shall not be permitted to compete at the Diving competition of Hangzhou 2022.

4.1.3 Artistic Swimming

The preferred family name used in the Sport Entry Form must be consistent with the preferred family name on the Accreditation Application Form.

Preferred given name

The preferred given name used in the Sport Entry Form must be consistent with the preferred given name on the Accreditation Application Form.

Internationally recognised name

Leave it blank if there isn't one.

Date of birth

Please enter the date(s) of birth in the following format: dd/mm/yyyy.

For example: November 12, 1998 = 12/11/1998

Height and weight

Please enter the athlete's height in centimetres (cm) and weight in kilograms (kg).

Accreditation number

This is a unique seven-digit number that identifies the athlete. It will be sent to NOCs by HAGOC. The accreditation number must be indicated on the Sport Entry Form.

Competitor's declaration

Please indicate the total time (in minutes and seconds) for the Duet and Team events.

Technical and Free Routine Section Time, Title and Composer

Please indicate the total time (in minutes and seconds), the title, and the composer for which each section of music is played (if applicable.)

Team Entry Policy

Duet

Each NOC may enter one (1) duet with a maximum of one (1) reserve gymnast.

Team

Each NOC may enter one (1) team which may consist of four (4) to eight (8) athletes with a maximum of two (2) reserve gymnasts.

Total

Each NOC may enter a maximum of ten (10) female athletes (including reserve gymnasts).

Age Limitation

Appendix III Eligibility Code

Understanding that as an athlete in the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022, I am participating in a sport which has ongoing continental and historic significance and in consideration of the acceptance of my participation therein, I agree to be filmed, televised, photographed, identified and otherwise recorded during the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 under the conditions now or hereafter authorized by the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA).

I agree to comply with the Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia and, in addition, the rules of my International Federation (IF), as approved by the International Olympic Committee in regarding the eligibility for the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 and the World Anti-Doping Code, the mass media and the prohibition on forms of publicity or propaganda on persons or on clothing and equipment worn or used at the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022.

I understand that the OCA Anti-Doping Rules refer to the World Anti Doping Code Prohibited List and any applicable amendments to that List.

My National Olympic Committee (NOC) and/or my National Sports Federation have brought the relevant provisions and rules to my attention.

I agree that all photographs and moving images taken by me at the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022, including those of athletes competing within any Games venues, shall be used solely for personal and non-commercial purposes, unless prior written consent is obtained from the Hangzhou Asian Games Organizing Committee (HAGOC).

I acknowledge that:

a. I participate in the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 at my own risk. I will take all reasonable measures to protect myself from the risks of participation; and

b. I am responsible for all property I bring into the venues of the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 and that neither HAGOC nor the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) accept any responsibility for any loss or damage to my property.

c. I understand that the OCA Anti-Doping Rules applicable to the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 apply from the opening to the closing of Asian Games Village and that I may be requested to provide urine, and/or blood samples in accordance with these Rules during this period.

I release OCA, HAGOC, the China National Olympic Committee (CNOC) (and their respective members, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, contractors or agents) from any liability (to the extent permitted by law) for any loss, injury or damage suffered in relation to my participation in the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022.

I agree that any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of, in connection with, or on the occasion of, the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022, not resolved after exhaustion of the legal remedies established by my NOC, the International Federation governing my sport, OCA and GAGOC, shall be submitted exclusively to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) for final and binding arbitration.

CAS shall rule in accordance with laws applicable in its jurisdiction and has the exclusive power to order provisional and conservatory measures. The decisions of CAS shall be final and binding. I shall not institute any claim, arbitration or litigation, or seek any other form of relief, in any other court or tribunal.

Appendix IV OCA Constitution and Rules (Extracts)

OCA Constitution and Rules, Chapter 3, Article 52, 53, 57 and 58 Eligibility Code

Article 52 Eligibility Code

To be eligible for participation in the OCA GAMES, a competitor must:

- 1. Observe and abide by the Rules of the IOC/OCA as per the Olympic Charter;
- 2. Respect the spirit of fair play and non-violence and abide by the rules on the sports field;
- 3. Comply with all aspects of WADA and OCA Anti-Doping Rules Code and refrain from using substances and drugs prohibited by the said organisations;
- 4. The Member must ensure that any competitor in the OCA GAMES must be a national of the country of the NOC, which is entering him;
- 5. Disputes relating to the determination of the country which a competitor may represent in the OCA GAMES shall be resolved by the EB, unless the eligibility code already set out in the Constitution has been fulfiled and is not in dispute.

Bye-law to Article 52

- 1. All cases of infringement of IOC Rule 41, 42 and it's Bye-laws and of the eligibility code of IFs shall be communicated by the concerned Member to the OCA, to be considered by the EB whose decision will be final;
- 2. A competitor who is a national of two (2) or more countries at the same time may represent either one (1) of them, as he may elect. However after having represented one country in the Olympic, Asian continental regional or world championships recognised by the relevant IF, the competitor may not represent another country unless he or she meets the conditions set forth in sub section 4 below that apply to the persons who has changed his nationality or acquired a new nationality;

- 3. A competitor who has represented one country in the Olympic Games, OCA GAMES, continental, regional, and world championships recognised by therelevant IF, and who has changed his nationality or acquired a new nationality, shall not participate in the OCA GAMES to represent his new country until three years after such change or acquisition;
- 4. If a State, Country or a colony acquires independence, a country becomes incorporated within another country by a change of border or transfer of sovereignty or if a new NOC is recognised by the OCA, a competitor may continue to represent the country to which he belong or belonged. However, he may, if preferred, choose to represent his country or be entered in the OCA GAMES by his new NOC if one exists. This option can only be made once and is irreversible;
- 5. In all cases not expressly addressed in these Bye-Laws, in particular those cases where a competitor would be in a position to represent a country other than that of which he is a national, or to have choice as to the country which he intends to represent, the EB makes all decisions. Decisions can be of a general or individual nature and issue specific requirements relating to nationality, citizenship, domicile or residence of the competitors, including the duration of any waiting period;
- 6. Except as permitted by the EB, no competitor, coach or official who participates in the OCA GAMES may allow his person, name and picture or sports performances to be used for advertising purposes during the OCA GAMES.

Article 53 Necessary Conditions for representing a Country

- 1. Only nationals of member NOCs are eligible to represent that country in the OCA GAMES. Where a competitor's nationality is the subject of scrutinization, evidence (passport, residency & other documents) must be produced to support and meet definition of eligibility, according to the rules prevailing in the particular sport in which the competitor wishes to take part. It is not permissible for a competitor having once represented a country in the OCA GAMES or any international sports competition such as Olympic Games, Asian Games, World Games, Continental Games, Regional Games etc., to represent a different country in the future unless:
- a. The former country or place of birth has since been incorporated in another State;

- b. Or if he/she competed for the former country because the NOC or Chief National Organisation of their native land was not a Member of the OCA at that time;
- c. The rules in relation to Article 49 byelaw 4 are met.
- 2. Competitors will be eligible if they comply with the following qualifications:
- a. That they were born in the country they represent;
- b. That they are nationals or citizens of the country they represent and have lived there continuously for a period of not less than three years;
- c. That they have become naturalised in the country they represent and have permanent residence there.
- 3. Competitors born outside Asia cannot be qualified unless they meet conditions in 2 b & c, where applicable.

Bye-law to Article 53

The OCA will have the full authority for disqualification of any athlete in all matters other than technical.

Article 57 Entries

- 1. Only the Member NOCs of OCA are responsible for the entries of their respective athletes and Officials in the OCA GAMES. A country without a NOC must form such an organisation and have it recognised by the OCA before it is permitted to take part in the OCA GAMES. The NOC has the sole authority to submit entries to the AGOC of the Games. The AGOC must acknowledge them;
- 2. Entry by Number

The NOCs must submit to the AGOC the list of the sports and events in which a NOCs will participate, with numbers, at least ninety (90) days before the Opening Ceremony. This list can be telexed/faxed/emailed or couriered. Under certain circumstance OCA can extend the deadline.

3. Entry by Name

The NOC's shall submit the entry by names of the Athlete and Officials to OCA/AGOC, at least Sixty (60)days before the Opening Ceremony. All entries must be printed or typewritten in duplicate on a special form prescribed by the AGOC. Any variation on the deadlines should have the written approval of the OCA;

- 4. As a condition precedent to taking part in the OCA GAMES a competitor must be eligible as defined in these Rules;
- 5. The entry shall contain the following statement, which must be signed by all participants: "I, the undersigned, declare on my honour that I am eligible and fulfil the Conditions stipulated by the OCA Rules and constitution. I am also fully aware of the OCA Anti-Doping Rules and the allowable trademark identification on clothing and equipment worn or used at the OCA GAMES as indicated in the Commercial Guidelines. Failing to comply with any of the above may result in penalties and my disqualification";
- 6. The National Sport Federations of that particular sport must countersign this declaration stating that it is true to the best of its knowledge. The NOC shall sign the form and forward entries to the AGOC;
- 7. In the event of there being no National Sport Federations for a particular sport in a country, the NOC may act as the governing Sport body and enter individuals in that sport with the approval of the OCA;
- 8. Entries will not be accepted unless all the conditions mentioned above are fully met;
- 9. The OCA may adopt some conditions to restrict participation in the Games to ensure manageability of the Games;
- 10. The withdrawal of a duly entered delegation, Team or Athletes without the consent of the OCA, shall be the subject of disciplinary action as envisaged by the EB.

Bye-law to Article 57

- 1. The EB determines the numbers of all participants in the OCA GAMES;
- 2. Where a NOC withdraws its delegation, whether in part or as a whole, the deposit for accommodation and all other monetary requirements shall be forfeited entirely or in the amount to be determined by the EB in case of partial withdrawal;
- 3. The OCA will levy financial and other penalties on any NOC which withdraws its team as a whole from team competitions after the draw is completed. The penalty will be decided by the EB, on a case by case basis.

Article 58 Number of Entries for the OCA GAMES

- 1. For a sport to be included in the OCA GAMES Programme a minimum of six (6) NOCs should enter their athletes by number and a minimum of four (4) should be physically present before the start of the competition;
- 2. The maximum number of entries from each country in each sport or event is established by the Council in consultation with the Member hosting the Games and in accordance with the International /Asian Federation's technical rules;
- 3. However, the following numbers cannot be exceeded:
- a. For individual events, two competitors from each Member;
- b. For team events, one team per Member, the Number of competitors and reserves not to exceed the number allowed by the International/Asian Sports Federation concerned;
- c. For events where individual and team competitions are conducted simultaneously, and the team event is decided by the aggregate score/time of each individual member of the team, the athlete (if maximum two) participating in the individual event must be designated as such in the Entry form and only the athlete concerned will be competing in the individual event. This restriction overrides any regulations of the International/Asian Sports Federation concerned.

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
